

MEMO TO MEMBERS OF
SHOREHAM SHORE CLUB, INC.
MAY 24, 2020

The beach is NOT officially open. We are hoping to open in accordance with our usual schedule (third week of June). Our ability to provide lifeguards remains dependent upon the Suffolk County Department of Health approving our application for a beach permit.

The gate will be open for Members to park. The gate will be closed approximately 1/2 hour after sunset.

MEMBERS ONLY (corporate and associate) rules are in effect meaning vehicles parked in the lower lot without a valid 2019 sticker risk being towed. 2020 vehicle stickers are expected to arrive the first week of June and will be mailed to members that have paid their 2020 dues and provided their vehicle(s) information on the invoice.

Non-members who are not guests of a member who is actually present at the beach will be asked to leave.

Deeded Beach Rights holders do NOT have the right to park in the lower lot. They can park at the top provided spots are available and they can walk onto the beach.

THE BATHROOM WILL NOT BE OPEN UNTIL THE BEACH IS OFFICIALLY OPEN.

NO SWIMMING AS THERE ARE NOT LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY.

SOCIAL DISTANCING PRACTICES ARE IN EFFECT. THERE IS NO GUARANTEE THAT SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE WILL NOT VISIT THE BEACH TO VERIFY COMPLIANCE WITH DISTANCING RULES OR THAT THEY WILL NOT ISSUE SUMMONSES TO INDIVIDUALS FOR NON-COMPLIANCE.

NO VOLLEYBALL OR SIMILAR ACTIVITIES ARE PERMITTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH TOWN, COUNTY AND STATE ORDERS IN EFFECT.
